### What's New In?

This screensaver turns any of your Media Player Vids into a Windows Media Player-powered

screensaver. The screensaver itself is a simple, animated, rotating snowflake, which rotates and expands/contracts from the center. You can also control the tempo of the rotating snowflake. The screen saver will actually show the first video in the series, regardless of the sequence of media files in the Media Library, and plays all videos in the series on one continuous loop. The screensaver also turns off any desktop icons, such as Internet Explorer (8), .pdf files, etc. When the screensaver is turned off, the Media Player windows still remain open in the desktop, and you can continue to work on them. In addition, you can access Media Player's controls to start, stop, pause, and play the videos. The videos are available as individual files, and there is no need to install Windows Media Player or use Windows Media Player's built-in DVD or media library viewer. If you use Windows Movie Maker 2 to create a video series, you can choose the desired video in Media Player and use Windows XP's Media Player Screensaver and Windows XP Media Player Screensaver add-in as the "extract from" setting. When it extracts, Windows XP automatically opens a dialog, prompts you to select your desired location, and uses that location as the target for the extracted video.

How To

1. Download and extract the zip file to the default screensaver directory (usually `\windows\screensavers\`).
2. You can find out the screen saver's directory by opening the screensaver properties.
3. Windows XP Screensaver will use the default location. Note that some third party screen savers may replace the default screensaver with their own. This is why the screensaver you download from the Internet may not be listed as a Windows XP Screensaver. You can add screensavers from the Internet to your list of Windows XP Screensavers, however. You can use the Windows XP Screensaver Properties dialog box to rename the screensaver if you want.
